What does an ALTAR SERVER do?

- Helps set up the church for mass
- Participates in the entrance procession
- Helps the priest and deacon during mass
- Helps at weddings, funerals, and other special masses

What are the QUALIFICATIONS to be an altar server?

- Fourth grade to seventh grade (no eighth graders, please)
 - Reliable and willing to serve at mass
 - Willing to participate in the prayers and songs during mass
(Your family does not need to be a member of the parish)

What does an ACOLYTE do?

- Helps direct the altar servers during mass set-up
- Leads the entrance procession
- Provides leadership during mass

What are the QUALIFICATIONS to be an ACOLYTE?

- Sixth grade or seventh grade **AND**
- Two years of successful altar server experience
(Your family does not need to be a member of the parish)
