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SACRAMENT REGISTRATION

Preparation for Confirmation is a two year program. We are pleased to partner with your family in preparing your teenage children for their reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. We grow spiritually when Church and family work together in helping faith to blossom. Parents are required to attend one orientation session the first year and a parents' meeting the second year. Parents and children are required to attend rehearsals. Families are expected to attend the weekly Sunday Liturgy. The Family Mass is at 9:00 A.M.

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers are needed and greatly appreciated. Parents volunteer in parish activities that benefit our Program. The following are the different programs we need your help in:

- Hospitality Sunday** (4th Sunday of every month after 9 A.M. and 10:30 A.M. Mass) -Contact parents and request baked goods, set up and staff food table;
- Teachers or Assistant Teachers**-One to two Sundays a month; **Office Help**-General office duties; **Dismissal Supervision**-Protecting children from traffic in the parking lot; **Safeguarding Our Children Committee**-Quarterly meeting; **Fund Raising**-Ideas and activities to defray training costs.
